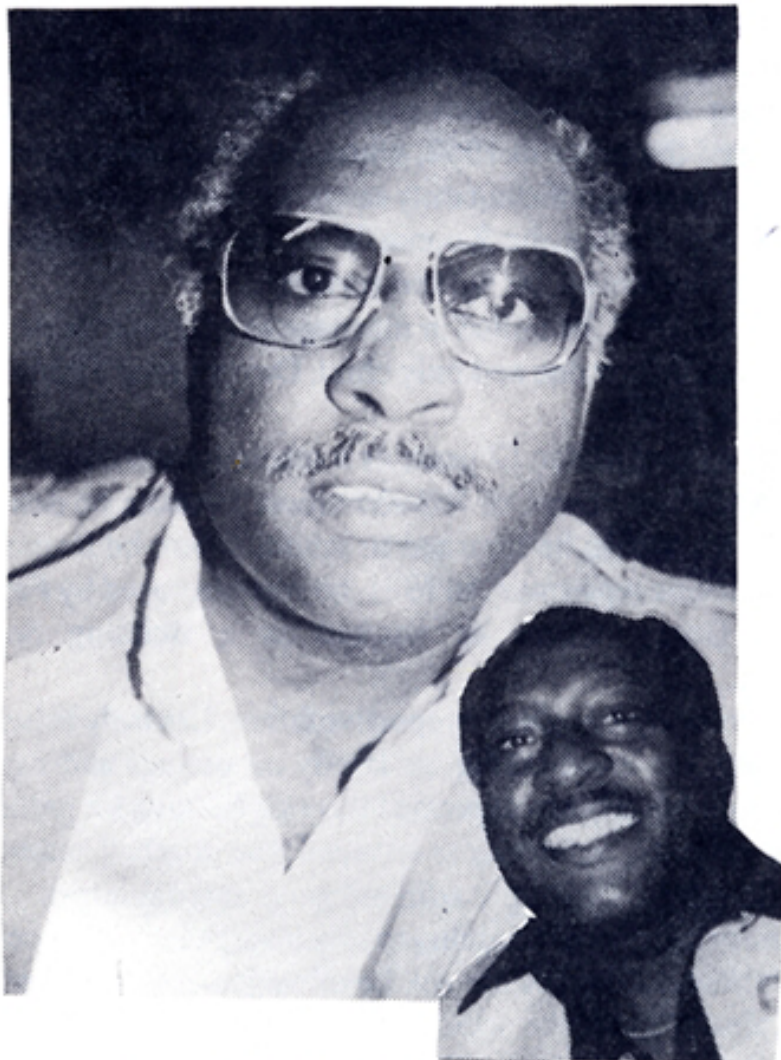

## *Obituary*

In Denison, Texas, April 13, 1935, A.J. and Arie Timmons were blessed with the birth of their son, **Leslie James Timmons**. Growing up in Denison in the communities of Rockhill and East Town, Les was well known among many as a person with much charm and wit. He befriended many while attending Terrell High School where he and his friends enjoyed their teen years together.

Les, joined the Navy in 1952, where he served as a motor boat operator. His most significant duty assignment was fleet activities in Inchon, Korea, during the Korean War. He was decorated with many honor medals for his faithful service.

On April 8, 1967, he united in marriage to Marjorie Bates. Their union produced their one and only child, David Leslie Timmons on February 27, 1971.

Les was employed for 17 years as a rehabilitation counselor for the California State Dept. of Rehabilitation. In 1981, he was employed by Farmer's Insurance Group where he worked as a Building Services Technician.

As a devoted husband and supportive father, Les truly believed in family unity. He loved taking his family on outings and camping trips. His love for life was expressed through his love for gardening, coaching his son's little league baseball and football teams, and listening to music. He deeply admired good entertainment.

His hearty laugh and the ability to solicit laughter from others will be greatly missed. As a proud man, Les always had an explanation of hope for the day's concern or problem. His inspiration of hope comes from his love and acceptance of his Savior Jesus Christ.

On Thursday, August 11, 1988 at 11:00 P.M., **Leslie James Timmons** departed this life. He leaves to cherish precious memories of him: his loving wife of 21 years, Marjorie Timmons; one son, David Leslie; mother, Arie Harris of Sacramento, CA.; brother and sister-in-law, Mr. & Mrs. Jim Levy Zachary, of Houston, Texas; and a host of devoted in-laws, nieces, nephews and many friends.
